Sentence Combining

- 1. **There were** *two* **chipmunks.** The chipmunks lived <u>once upon a time</u>.
- 2. They would pile nuts too high. The piled them every day.
- 3. **They would be sure** *to* **have plenty of food.** They'd be sure to have it <u>next January</u>.
- 4. **One chipmunk piled too many nuts.** The chipmunk piled them <u>a certain way</u>.
- 5. The other piled them. It piled them another way.
- 6. One chipmunk left the other alone. It left one October morning.
- 7. Hawks attacked each chipmunk. Hawks attacked them that evening.
- 8. **The two chipmunks were reunited.** The were reunited three days later.
- 9. There is safety in numbers. There is safety every time.
- 10. We don't have to do things. We don' have to do them the same way.
