## Sentence Combining: Odysseus

**New Directions:** Use what you have learned about combining subjects and making sure that the verbs agree with them. The first four sets will form the first paragraph about Odysseus. Sets five through nine form the second; sets 10 through 13 form the last paragraph.

- 1. **Odysseus has many adventures.** <u>His men</u> have many adventures. (and) Their adventures are unusual.
- 2. **Their first adventure happens.** The first adventure is <u>important</u>. It happens <u>in the land</u>. It is the land <u>of the Lotus-eaters</u>.
- 3. **Some members eat the lotus.** They are members <u>of Odysseus's crew</u>. They <u>lose their memory</u>. (,) They <u>want to remain forever</u>. (, and) They want to remain forever <u>with the Louts-eaters</u>.
- 4. These men have to be carried. These men are <u>foolish</u>. They have to be carried to their ships. They have to be carried by force.

- 5. **The land provides the next adventure.** It is the land <u>of the Cyclopes</u>. The adventure is <u>exciting</u>. The adventure is <u>strange</u>.
- 6. **The Cyclopes are a tribe.** They are a tribe <u>of giants</u>. The giants are <u>ugly</u>. The giants are <u>barbaric</u>. (,) The giants are <u>one-eyed</u>. (, and)
- 7. **One Cyclops finds Odysseus.** The Cyclops find <u>his men</u>. (and) He finds them <u>in a cave</u>. **The Cyclops closes the mouth of the cave**. (, so) He closes the mouth <u>with a rock</u>. The rock is <u>huge</u>.
- 8. **The Cyclops kills two men.** He kills them <u>then</u>. He <u>eats them</u>. (and) He eats them for dinner.
- 9. Odysseus must make a plan. It is a plan of escape. The Cyclops will eat them all. (, or) The Cyclops is <u>hungry</u>.

- 10. **Odysseus calls himself "Noman." He wants to hide his identity.** (, for) That identity is <u>real</u>.
- 11. **He puts out the Cyclops's eye.** He puts it out with the point. It is the point of a stake. The stake is burning. The puts it out that night.
- 12. The Cyclops yells. He yells to his friends. He says "Noman" has blinded him. (, but) They think the Cyclops has gone mad. (, so)
- 13. **The Cyclops tries to catch Odysseus.** The Cyclops is <u>blind</u>. The Cyclops tries <u>hard</u>. The Cyclops tries to catch <u>some of his men</u>. (or) **They escape**. (, but) They escape <u>under the bellies</u>. They are the bellies <u>of sheep</u>.
