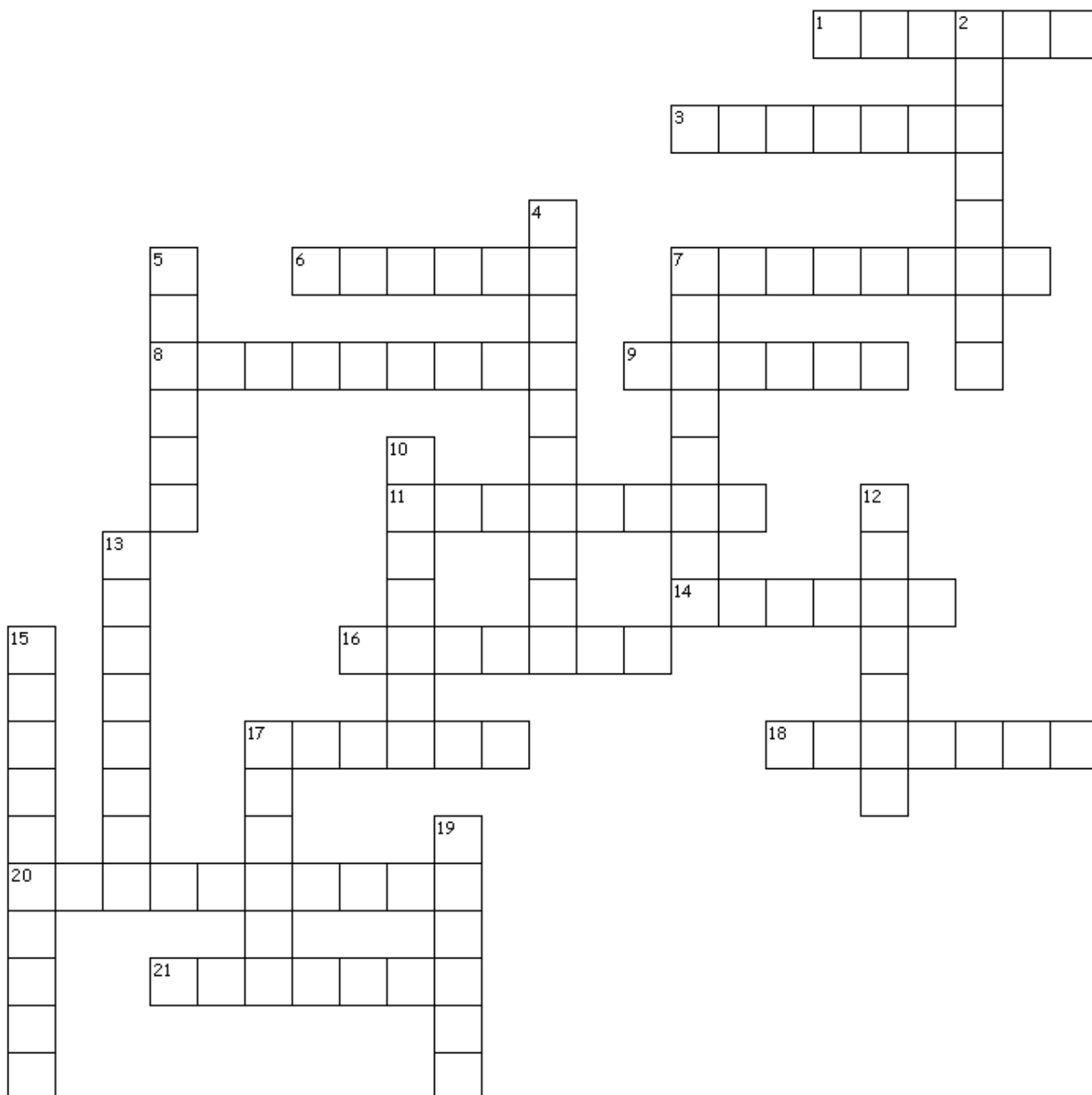


Spelling Lesson 05: Easily Confused Words
